

How to Use Emergency Ride Home

What is it?

- The Sonoma Emergency Ride Home (ERH) Program will reimburse rides home in cases of emergency for anyone who works in Sonoma County and made the effort to avoid commuting alone in their car. You can have peace of mind taking the bus, train, carpool, vanpool, bicycling, or walking to work, knowing that you can be reimbursed for a ride home in the case of a qualifying emergency.

Who is eligible?

- You are eligible to use ERH if you work in Sonoma County and commute using an alternative transportation option such as public transit (bus or train), carpooling, vanpooling, bicycling, or walking.
- If an unexpected circumstance arises (e.g., illness, injury, crisis, breakdown of carpool or vanpool vehicle, breakdown of bicycle, unscheduled overtime) on the day you used an alternative commute mode, you can be reimbursed for a ride home via taxi, public transit, Uber, Lyft, car share, or rental car.

How does the program work?

1. Review the ERH Program Rules www.scta.ca.gov/erh
2. Complete your ride home in case of a qualifying emergency and save your receipt
3. Download and complete this reimbursement form, certifying your agreement to the ERH Program Rules, and W-9 www.scta.ca.gov/erh
4. Email the reimbursement form, the W-9 form, and ride receipt to SonomaERH@scta.ca.gov
