Please comment on whether a ferry service from Vallejo to Marin county is feasible.if not, why ? There is already a ferry building established in Vallejo and there's also at least one in Marin County with easy connections to Transit to get around Marin county.

If this was an option I would use instead of driving to San Rafael to work.

I avoid 37 wherever possible due to a poor use of my time gas and wear and tear on my car. And if 37 alone weren't bad enough it's also the 101 heading south to get to San Rafael after I get through 37. The only option I'm left with if not 37 is taking 80 to 580 and crossing Richmond bridge to get San Rafael and this is also a mess because traffic gets very impacted about 1-2 miles before the Richmond bridge. I start work at 8:00 but I have to leave my house in Vallejo by 6:30am or earlier because my drive time is consistent just over an hour at best and sometimes 2 hours due to traffic conditions. I have to pay two tolls each day I go to work One for Richmond bridge and one for the bridge going into Vallejo.

I would love to have an alternative to this that doesn't take forever and doesn't cost me a fortune. I would prefer to never have to do this kind of commute and would prefer to work in the city I have lived in for over 13 years however Vallejo does not pay well .

I would support a new ferry service over a BART line because creating a new line is going to take a long time and it's going to be expensive for taxpayers.
